

[00:00:00] Hi. Did you know that TAP interactions can be incredibly effective to chi content into different categories in your ear intercourse? And therefore, in this video I'll show you step by step how you can create a mobile inspired taps interaction in store line 360. Are you ready? And let's get started. And now let's dive in straight into storyline for this mobile inspired depth Interac.

[00:00:23] I created a slide with a basic designing article. At Storyline. On the left, you'll see a title text, an introduction text, and a text that says, Select the icons on the mobile phone to learn more. So what my idea is that there are four buttons on the mobile phone, and if you click one of the buttons, you'll see the content that is over that specific topic.

[00:00:44] Now the first step is to create the buttons, offer taps interaction. I have already one button in place, but it's not finished, so let's finish the first button. , I want icons on the buttons, on the tabs interaction already found four icons. You'll see them here and I found them here. So if you go to the intro tab and here to icons in the content library of Articulate 360, you can find a lot of icons.

[00:01:09] I already selected four, and I will place them on the buttons. So let's finish the first button. So what I'll do is, Copy this icon and I'll press control X on my keyboard and now I'll go to my button, go here to my state step, click on added states, and now I can paste it here on my normal state. So it will be paste it on the position where it was on my slide, so I have to reposition it so I will.

[00:01:39] Here. So it's in the middle of my button right now, and what I now can do is copy it and paste it to the other states. Wait a moment and copy it and paste it to my other states.

[00:01:56] So I've paced the icon to the other states. And because my selected state is the background is lighter, I changed the feel color of the icon. And what I can do now is I can hear, click on, done and copy this button, and I change the icon for the other buttons. So what I will do now is I'll create the other three buttons.

[00:02:18] So what I'll do is I'll copy this button and I paste it three times. And now I will align them. So I'll press control on my keyboard and I will select them all. I'll go now to arrange here, align and distribute horizontally. And you'll see now that they're horizontally distributed evenly. So that's okay.

[00:02:39] So what I have to do now is add the icons to the different buttons. That is the next step. I added the R three icons to the other buttons, so that's

okay for now. So what I have to do now is add the text label to the other buttons so I can copy this text and paste it underneath the other buttons. And then what All I have to do is I'll change the text label.

[00:03:03] So all four buttons now have a text label. I will press control on my keyboard, go to Align and distribute Horizon. So there are distributed horizontally and also aligned top. So they're aligned. Now. I will now change the text labels and then we can continue. So I've created the text labels for all the buttons, and the next step is to create a slide layer and here will be the contents of the different types.

[00:03:33] So I'll go here to. Slide layer and there is now a new slide layer that will change the name by double clicking on it, and it will change the name in layer one. And now we can place content here on the layer. So let's add a title. So what I can do is I can press control and t on my keyboard and type in solar and can align this and I can press control T again.

[00:03:59] And what I can type now is lu and bracket one end bracket. And if I press enter article storyline now automatically. Adds one paragraph of Lauren s and text. I will make the text a little bit smaller. So 16 is okay and the width is, for instance, 400 pixels. It has to be a little bit smaller. And I will change the text size to 14 pixels.

[00:04:28] So this is okay. And what I can do for instance, is now also at the solar icon here. So I've pasted my icon. The icon is now here. I will position into here and I'll change the fill and it can be larger than this. For instance, 80 pixels. Let's make it 60. I think that's better. So you see where have here the icon, so it matches with the icon on the button.

[00:04:57] We have the title and I will center align it so it's center aligned and here is my contents. And I can also copy this layer and do the same for the other layers. To copy a layer, I can hear press on copy and the layer will automatically be copied. And all the contents of layer one is now also in layer two.

[00:05:23] So I'll change the name here. And instead of solar I tip in Earth here. And I have to Change the icon, but is something I can do later on. And now I'll copy layer two and make it layer three, layer four. Now I've created my third and fourth layer, and what I've also done is I copied the logos or the icons as you see here, the icon for layer four, layer three, layer two, and layer one.

[00:05:48] And the next step is to add some triggers to the buttons that if you click on the button, the corresponding layer will open. So let's select bottom one here. And now I go here to triggers. My trigger panel will open, and here I'll choose show layer, and this layer will be layer four when the user clicks on button solar.

[00:06:08] So this is, okay, so we do now the same for button two, three, and four. So I'll select button two and go to trigger, I said that show layer, and this will be layer two here, button three, you trigger. Show layer three. And here this will be button four and it will show layer four. So now we attach the triggers to the buttons, and if you click on a button, a layer will open.

[00:06:39] So let's preview our screen and see how these steps animation looks right now. So we are in preview mode. So select the first button to see if it works. Now you'll see the solar layer will open and this step is selected. Now let's add click on button two. And you'll see that we now have a problem because now button one and button two are both selected.

[00:07:00] So those is something we don't want. And you'll see if I click button two and three, the layer for button three will open. And for button four, the layer for button four will open. But you see all four. Buttons are now selected and that is something we don't want. So this is something we are gonna fix.

[00:07:17] And also the selected state is not that clear, so that's also something I want to do something about it. But first, let's, But first, let's fix that. Not all buttons can be selected at the same time. So let's close our preview and what we'll do is now we'll select all the buttons on the base layer. So I've select all four buttons.

[00:07:38] I'll right click with my mouse. And what I'll do now is I'll select button set and then button set one. What a button set does is it acts the same as radio buttons. So now only one of the buttons can be selected at the same time. Now, to test this, let's preview our slide again. So we are back in our preview mode.

[00:07:58] So let's select our first button and the tab will open. And if I now select my second button and the second tab will open, and you'll see now only the second button is selected and not my first button. And what I will also want to do is create a little bit more. Visual cue of what is selected. So I will add a purple line here.

[00:08:22] So I've closed my preview mode, so what I want to do now is add the extra indicator for a selected state. So I'll go here to my state step, click on added states. Now I'll select the selected state, and here I go to insert shape and I choose a rectangle. And what I'll do here is draw a little rectangle and I format it.

[00:08:46] I give it the shape fill. And it has no outline. And I will position it a little bit lower Now I'll position it on the line. So this is okay, I think. And now what I can do is I can copy the rectangle also to the other buttons. I've added the purple rectangle also to my other three buttons. So let's preview the steps, interaction for the finals time to see how it looks like.

[00:09:10] So we're improving mode and let's look at our mobile. Steps interaction. So what I do now is I click the first button, you'll see the layer will open, and also the purple rectangles here if, and I'll click on the second layer or the second button. The second layer will open and the purple rectangles here.

[00:09:28] And it's also for third button and for the fourth button. So this is the steps interaction inspired on a mobile.
